Program: Our wonderful Lenny gave us an update on advances in CPR – actually he feels that it should be named CCR replacing the P (Pulmonary) with the C (Cerebral) as it is most important to get the blood to the brain; he brought his new best buddy Braydon – who demonstrates the CCR function of resuscitation. Lenny clearly explained the difference between a heart attack and cardiac arrest. Only 7% who have cardiac arrest survive. CPR should be mandated – high schoolers in many areas cannot graduate without the CPR course – and police should be retrained every two years not just in their academy training. We were told that the most important thing is to call for help and begin compressions, you CANNOT be sued and you CANNOT press too hard as the person is already dead and you are trying to revive them. The rate is 100 per minute and very tiring and when giving the chest compressions teach the next person to take over the task. The AED has been a true lifesaver and cannot shock if not needed. Lenny then talked about choking and how to see the signs and how to perform the maneuver needed.

Lenny it is always a joy to hear you teach. Your passion, your knowledge and your presentation is always meaningful for those you are lucky to hear you. Thanks so very much.
