Program: Brought to our Club today by the talented Editor of "Our Town" Newspaper our own club member **Mr. Art Aldrich.** Art in his spare time teaches and advises students, Gov't officials and others on Municipal guidelines along with collective bargaining issues. In a follow-up to a previous program on the country of China and its economic standing in the world, Arthur presented information on the leading province in the country – **Chongqing.**

Art met with a **delegation of Municipal Officials, Communist Party Officials and Labor representatives at the Orangetown Town Hall,** along with the Orangetown representatives to discuss the collective bargaining process.

Some interesting Facts: A) The Chinese culture is the oldest in World History going back over 5,000 years. **B)** The Chinese approach to ideas, politics and their trade dealings with the Western/European cultures is to assimilate the best ideas into the Chinese School of thought. **C)** The province of **Chongging** is the **fastest growing** province of China in both population and economic growth. This Chongging province is modernizing its capitalistic economy while still being connected to its past ancient culture and values. **D)** The businesses still rely on a sweat shop mentality with mandatory overtime, low poverty rated wages along with which the Government and their businesses still continue to exploit its workers. Art relayed his conversations with this delegation where there is an obvious divide between the Eastern/European business model & governmental procedures to the Far Eastern Chinese concepts of assimilation. These ideas represent the Chinese way of economic and Industrial development. **E)** Scholars have some factual evidence that the **Chinese discovered the America's** with its large Navy in 1406-1407 under the guidance of an Admiral Ho. This fleet comprised over 62 ships, 28,000 naval personnel and was estimated to of had 7 major fleet voyages. All of this was accomplished prior to the 1492 voyage of Columbus in 3 smaller ships on his discovery route across the Atlantic Ocean. F) Finally, the country of China along with its major province of Chongging are growing and developing into a dominant super power that is growing at a yearly rate of 8.5% & 9% of GNP. The Chinese seek to assimilate to the order of what they seek to dominate. Are the United States and the increasing debt to China being baited into assimilation? Only time will tell if this will happen! A Game of Strategy between the United States & China that the Chinese are economically winning!
