**The Program:** Brought to our Club through Kirk (Happy to be Here!) Flynn presented by Mark (To the Rescue!) GriffithJr.

Ms. Patricia Dempire – Who graduated from Spring Valley H.S. decided to make a difference in her native homeland of Haiti. After the original January Earthquake in Haiti devastated the Island, Patricia assisted the children of Haiti by providing desperately needed education that was lost by the tragedy. She started an Educational Camp that was a way to supply the kids with some of the learning experience that was lost and now unavailable. The new educational camp began in a Church where the pews were used as the school benches. Additionally the pews were used as tables for the hot meals they received while attending the day's activities. Eventually through various personal and family donations a few tables & chairs were acquired for the students to help with their eating & learning experience. These camp students also were able to learn the French language from a teacher hired by the church who promoted the teaching/learning skills. These Haitian Children are living in (1) room shacks where food is hard to come by on a regular basis.

The **Question** that needs to be answered is all the tremendous relief work and donations provided by the United States, Where does the relief "**Money**" **Go!** Even the great work provided by the **Bill Clinton-George Bush** "**41**" Presidential combined relief effort needs to be reevaluated to direct the aid to those truly in need.

**Patricia** provided the additional necessary education in teaching English along with other social and life organizational skills.
