Pearl River is hosting the 50th St. Patrick's Day Parade and Ray is honored to be the Grand Marshall. His father Ray Sr. helped organize the original parade and was the first Grand Marshall. That parade took place in Haverstraw due to the large Irish population working the brickyards for the construction of most of the

buildings in NYC. New City also hosted the parade in early years but in 1965 Pearl River, with wide streets and a staging area at Lederle, (now Pfizer), became the permanent home. Pearl River, Ancient Order of Hibernians Division #3, is the largest of any Division in America, totaling over 800 members.
