## Program: Brought to us by: Jay Helman & Dave Pritchett "The Bee-Keeper"

An informative program of "Save the Bee & Save the World" which revealed many documented facts on the necessity to increase the Bee population.

- 1. **Honey Bees** provide much more than Honey such as these other uses: ointment for burn victims, Skin Care, Energy source, Furniture Wax and the 1st Alcoholic Beverage "Mead Wine".
- 2. **Honey Bees** are about 14 million years old and now colonies are disappearing from contamination from Pesticides and other commercial operations.
- 3. The Queen will live 3 to 5 years and can mate with 18-50 Drones.
- 4. There is only (1) Queen for each colony which can consist of 40M Bees.
- 5. 2 Acres of Farmland are lost every day which causes a loss of the Bee population, while the human population is increasing at a rapid rate.
- 6. The Honey Bee is not an aggressive Bee unless there is a direct threat at the Queen, the Nest or for its own immediate survival.
- 7. A species of African Bees are aggressive bees and are now in the US.
- 8. **Apiaries –** Is the name for the **Bee-Keepers** of multiple Bee Hives.
- 9. If a Queen dies the workers will create an emergency cell to create a new Queen Bee to represent the swarm in the laying of eggs for the colony.
