Jim Murphy & Past Paul Harris Award Winner Jim Shepard.



The over-riding philosophy of the organization is of handicapped consumer rights protection and providing initiatives for compliance to the Federal American with Disabilities Act of laws and regulations. This center provides a service and handles the need of many individuals with handicapped abilities to improve and better their living environment. These initiatives and services certainly make the world a better place to live for people with disabilities. It also serves as notice that the United States of America along with its charitable organizations cares about all of its citizens and their independent right to a high quality of life.
