Volunteers under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult during the entire shift.

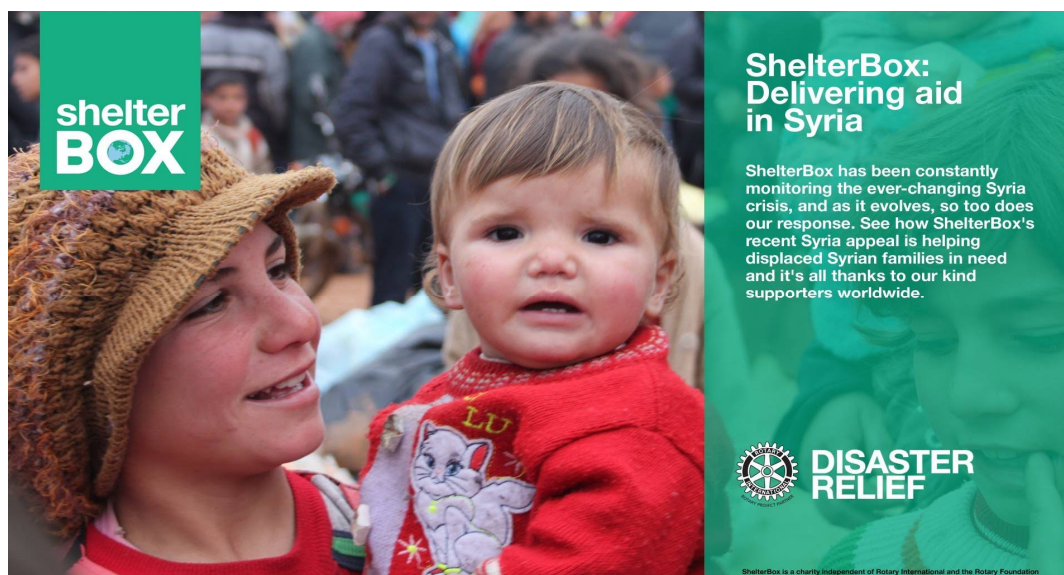
