Today was our first meeting at our new location, Murray's in Tivoli, NY. Everyone seemed to be happy with Murray's.

Past President Bud Weaver led our meeting in the absence of President Tim Lynch. Bud reminded club members that District Governor Jim Damiani will make his official visit on August 8, 2017.

Hon. Joel Griffiths, Village of Tivoli Mayor, welcomed our club to our new meeting location in Tivoli. Mayor Griffiths spoke to us about the Village's Water and Waste Water systems. Both systems are nearly 80 years old. The Village Board obtained an \$80,000 grant to fund an engineering study of the systems. The engineering firm examined every inch of pipe, every manhole and the physical plants of the systems. The engineering study reveals that 9.5 million dollars will be needed to bring the two systems up to date. Quite a large nut for a small village to crack. Projections show that quarterly rates will double in 5 years. Options to be considered by Village residents is to try to raise funds through the Village or transfer ownership to Dutchess Water and Waste Water Authority. The Mayor feels a bit frustrated because this is an important decision for Village residents. Two information forums were held with only 29 residents attending the first and 31 at the second. Another forum maybe scheduled.
