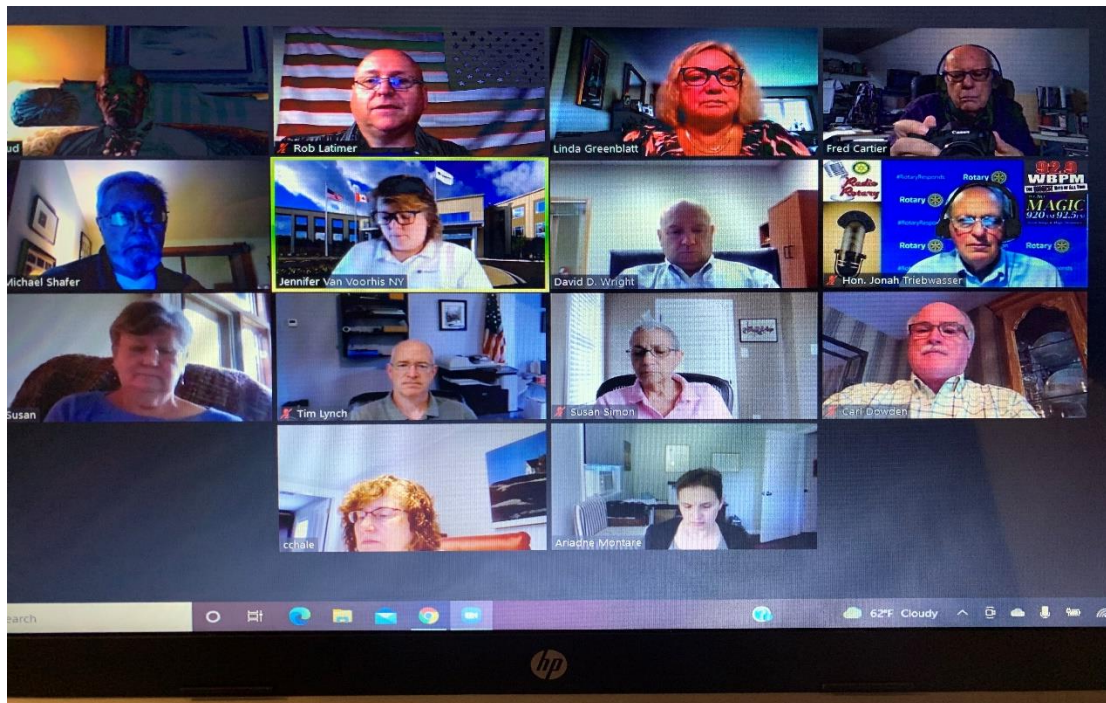

asked club members to sign up to make food deliveries. The need to deliver food remains high, but the numbers volunteering to do so has dropped. All of the food pantry work that had been at the Elks Club has now moved to the Community Center, which has the necessary storage.
