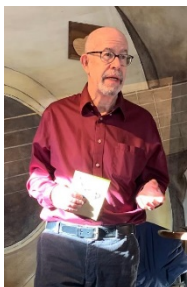

He discussed how archaic the franchising agreement with cable is (hasn't been revised since 1992), how "weak" NYS is in public access TV funding, and the difficulties that PANDA has faced including old & outdated equipment but they DO have hope for their future – PANDA will be relocating to the Red Hook Community Center in May. New technology has become more affordable – with the possibility of much needed financing they have the goal to upgrade their equipment & technology, resume broadcasting, host & produce community TV productions and continue being a communications resource. Currently you can view broadcasts on YouTube and some programs are posted on their website as well.
