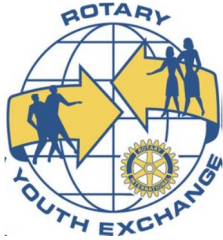


Attendance was 76% of membership. No Happy dollars today due to the length of our program.

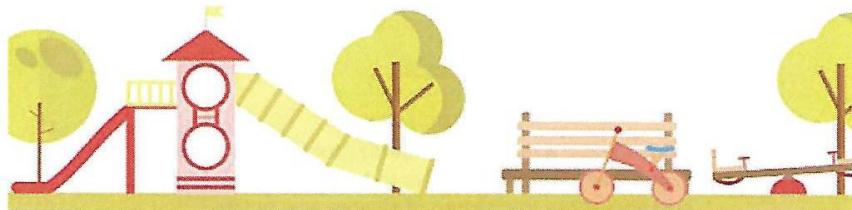
