They mentioned that Historic Red Hook came to life when Friends of Elmendorf Inn and the Egbert Benson Historical Society were combined. Historic Red Hook wants to be the hub, resource and repository of Red Hook history. They are interested in collecting stories of Red Hook.

Historic Red Hook recently purchased the property next door to the Elmendorf Inn at 5 Cherry Street. The new location will have

exhibit space on the first floor and storage on the second floor. Changes are being made to the new campus. Parking has been moved behind 5 Cherry St and the former parking area is becoming a village green where concerts and other outdoor activities will happen. Historic Red Hook has launched a capital campaign to fund the village green project and in the future remodeling and upgrading the kitchen of Elmendorf Inn.

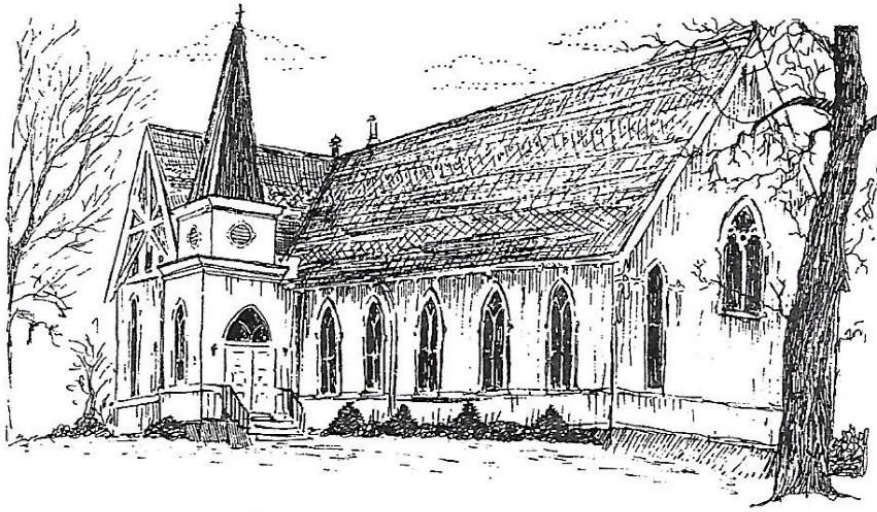
