Jen provided a quick update on the coat drive. We will be picking up the coats at the collection sites on Saturday, October 17, 2020 and delivering to the Red Hook United Methodist Church beginning at 11 am and finishing at 2pm. Racks and hangers will be available at the church where the distribution of coats will be organized.

Linda Greenblatt introduced our guest speaker, Amelia LeGare, from The O=ZONE on Pitcher Lane across from the Greig Farm. Amelia opened O-ZONE on March 1, 2020. She told us that the dual themes of recycling and sustainability inspired her to open the center, which is located just east of Grandiflora on Pitcher Lane. The center includes a zero-waste sustainability center, bulk refill stations (which promote a reduction in packaging by asking customers to bring in their own containers and buy grains, flour and other items from bulk containers) locally produced soap and shampoo bars and other products. They promote composting, sponsor a learning center and have a number of upcoming events at any time and offer c-Pap machine parts replacements. There hours are W - F 11-5, S 10-6, and S 10-4.

We thanked Amelia for all that she does for the community and suggested she consider Rotary membership.
