Marking the 29th week of “stay at home” meetings required by the coronavirus outbreak, Jen Van Voorhis opened the “zoom” meeting at 8am. Twelve Rotarians attended the meeting. Jen Van Voorhis presided, leading off the meeting with the pledge and the Rotary 4-way test. Reverend Fred Cartier offered the blessing.

Linda Greenblatt provided a member story, as our featured speaker. She talked about growing up in Callicoon, NY on her parents chicken farm as well as her decision not to go to the Woodstock Festival because the entry fee was too high. Then, she shared the story of losing her brother, who enlisted as a Seabee, in the Viet Nam war. Today was the 50th anniversary of his death. He was killed by a land mine in Viet Nam and is much missed by his sister. She also recollected the events at Kent State. The fiftieth anniversary will occur on November 4, 2020. Her husband, Jay Greenblatt, was asked by the Superintendent of Schools to stay in his post, and he did. Linda’s story evoked lots of other memories of this difficult time in US history. It led Linda to teach history in the Red Hook schools.

Jen updated the group on the Coat Drive. Signs are out, collections stations established. The final date for distribution of the new, gently-used, clean coats is November 17, 2020.

The check in the amount of \$2,272.90 has been delivered to the Library for the Wi-Fi project. Barry Ramage, Karen Cadorette and Gayle Wolff have been contacted.
