The Red Hook Rotary Club and Red Hook Rotary Foundation are pleased to announce that three scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to students planning to attend an accredited school.

Each applicant must be a graduating senior and a legal resident of the Red Hook Central School District, Pine Plains School District or Germantown Central School District. Awards will be based on involvement in community service activities, leadership potential, and communication skills. Scholarships may be awarded to a student attending an accredited four year or community college, vocational school or trade certificate program.

Scholarship awards will be distributed to the winning student to reimburse the student for any educational expense (eg. tuition, required books, computer, required equipment, etc.).

Scholarship applicants must submit the following:

- 1. Completed scholarship application
- 2. An up-to-date transcript
- 3. Three (3) letters of reference; one of the letters MUST be from your school guidance counselor

A selection committee composed of members of the Red Hook Rotary Club will review your completed application package. Keep in mind that the committee will look for candidates who most exemplify the notable traits of Rotary, including goodwill, leadership, and service to others.
