The Red Hook Rotary Foundation is pleased to announce its scholarships for 2026. Scholarships will be awarded to students planning to attend an accredited school or trade certificate program.

Each applicant must be a graduating senior and a legal resident of the Red Hook Central School District, Pine Plains School District or Germantown Central School District. Awards will be based on involvement in community service activities, leadership potential, and communication skills. Scholarships may be awarded to a student attending an accredited four year or community college, vocational school or trade certificate program.

Scholarship applicants must submit the following:

- 1. Completed scholarship application indicating the scholarship(s) applying for**
- 2. An up-to-date transcript**
- 3. Three (3) letters of reference; one of the letters MUST be from your school guidance counselor**

A selection committee composed of members of the Red Hook Rotary Club will review your completed application package. Keep in mind that the committee will look for candidates who most exemplify the notable traits of Rotary, including goodwill, leadership, and service to others.

Rotary International is a volunteer organization of business and professional leaders who provide humanitarian service and help to build goodwill and peace in the world. Rotary International's focus areas include polio eradication, peace, humanitarian projects, literacy, and water management.
