MINUTES FROM THE ROTARY CLUB OF POINT WEST MEETING HELD ON September 12, 2023

Meeting called to order at 7:30 by President Roger Gilleland.

Approval of the minutes from meeting held on August 8, 2023

Motion by Desiree Wilson to approve the minutes as presented. Second by Dorthe Wright. **Action: approved unanimously.**

Treasurer Report

Desiree reviewed the financials:

Profit and Loss highlights: loss of \$653.97 on meals at Del Paso, received the annual \$7,500 administration fee from the PWR Foundation for the Club running the fundraisers, \$135 from members on zoom, clarification on budget for Club pins.

Balance Sheet highlights: Deferred dues: \$2,055 (Desiree is sending out reminders.) Will be transferring a portion of the \$68,254 to a new savings account. Will need approval from the Board and a resolution. Motion by Paul Cunha to open a new savings account at First Citizen's Bank with Roger Gilleland, Paul Cunha and John Price as signors. Second by Dorthe Wright.

Action: approved unanimously.

Community Investment Budget highlights: clarification on the \$3,352 for Human Trafficking being held in the Club CI budget. GRC will do the due diligence when a recipient is selected. Will be paid by the PWR Foundation. Roger noted that we have received a matching grant of \$5,000 from the district for a total of \$10,000 targeted for Human Trafficking at Katherine Johnson Middle School and Greer Elementary School.

Currently \$8,300 in the Maui fund. Will continue to take donations from Club members until the end of September. Hope to raise \$10,000. Motion by Bob Berger to approve the budget reports as presented. Second by Paul Cunha. **Action: approved unanimously.**

Mike Garcia, Grant Review Committee Chair: Update & Board approvals required

Mike advised the Board that the GRC received a total of \$91,008 in grant requests from Greer Elementary, Katherine Johnson Middle School and Encina High School. GRC members Mark Albrecht, Paul Adams and Sandy Thompson completed the due diligence. On August 30, 2023, the GRC reviewed the requests and recommendations and approved a total of \$40,265. This includes \$14,500 for Greer, \$9,000 for KJM and \$16,765 for Encina. Each individual grant was under \$5,000, except one \$7,000 grant for KJM.

Motion by Bob Berger to approve all sixteen grants submitted by the GRC for the three schools, including the one individual grant greater than \$5,000 for a total grant request of \$40,265. Second by John Price. **Action: approved unanimously.**

Goal for the Maui Relief is \$10,000. Currently, the balance is \$8,300 in the CI budget as mentioned in the financial report. Motion by Paul Cunha to approve matching funds from the CIB to get to \$10,000 for Maui Relief. Second by Greg Garcia. **Action: approved unanimously.**

Brewfest 2023: Tom Engwer and Jesse Nix

Bob Berger gave the update and stated everything is a go.

Some concern regarding the signups for manpower.

Roger will send an email to members, stating we need all members to participate!

Will need help on the Beer Relay Race. Capital Race Mgt will clean up!

"What is Rotary" tent will be set up. John Price organizing.

Dominic talked about the QR code that attendees can use that is a guide to the Brewfest and vote on beers. Joanie volunteered to advise folks of this code at the entrance.

Members do not need to install fencing this year.

T- shirts for volunteers will be distributed at the September 15, 2023, Club meeting. 6:30 AM setup.

There will be an information booth.

Don Rodes and the Interact students will do the cleanup.

The photographer will be the same as last year.

All volunteers must have a ticket to enter.
