



Financial Obligations

Annual Membership Dues (July 1 – June 30)

\$310

- Discounted to \$300 if paid by cash, check or Venmo
- First year is pro-rated based on the date joined
- Invoiced after being read-in
- Make check payable to Point West Rotary OR Venmo to @PointWest-Rotary
- Dues reduced to \$232 for members under 40. Reduced further to \$225 if paid by cash, check or Venmo

Quarterly Meeting/Breakfast Fee

\$279

- Discounted to \$270 if paid by cash, check or Venmo
- First quarter is pro-rated based on date joined
- Invoiced after being read-in
- Make check payable to Point West Rotary or Venmo to @PointWest-Rotary
- Rule of 85 eligible members may pay reduced amount of \$237, or \$230 if paid by cash, check or Venmo

The Rotary Foundation Contribution

\$100

- New members are required to contribute to TRF upon joining (\$100 is strongly encouraged)
- Continuing members are required to contribute to TRF annually (\$100 is strongly encouraged)
- Make check payable to The Rotary Foundation and give to the club's Rotary Foundation Chair

Point West Rotary Club Foundation (PWRCF)

\$100

- New members are required to contribute to PWRCF upon joining (\$100 is strongly encouraged)
- Continuing members are required to contribute to PWRCF (\$100 is strongly encouraged)
- Make check payable to Point West Rotary Club Foundation and give to the PWRCF Treasurer

Membership Expectations

Participation in major fundraisers (Brewfest, Golf Tournament)

- Serve on the committee and/or work the day of the event
- Purchase and/or sell the required number of event tickets or contribute an equivalent amount (Brewfest)

Service

- Participate in one or more service/work projects annually (i.e., Partners in Leadership Youth Conference, AR Parkway Cleanup, Rotarians at Work Day)
- Serve on one or more of the many committees in the club
