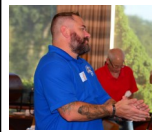

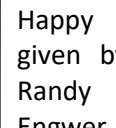
gave us the thought for the day. Paul Friedrich and our newest member, Lisa Lilienthal gave a 2x2. Brewfest support
