Another milestone for planet Earth was set last week with records for the hottest daily average global air temperature. Surpassing the previous record from 2016, 3 July had an average of 17.01°C (62.62°F). That was surpassed on 4 and 5 July with 17.18°C (62.92°F). The new record high from 6 July, with average global air temperature recorded 2 meters above Earth's surface reaching 17.23° C (63.01°F). The last time Earth was this warm was in the Eemian interglacial period, around 120,000 years ago. Try to stay cool.
