#### **Instructions to sign up for Venmo:**

1.Download one of the mobile apps for iOS or Android (Venmo

does not have a Windows app) – see the icon (right) to make sure you download the correct app



- 2. Open the Venmo app
- 3.Choose your sign up method and create a secure password (between 8 and 20 characters long, and should contain at least one number or symbol like (! @#\$%)).
- 4. Verify your phone number and email address
- 5.Add and verify your bank account
- 6.To send payment to our club or Foundation, enter PWR's address @PointWest-Rotary, enter the amount and make sure you identify/note what you're paying for (breakfast, Bowling Bash, donation, etc.)
