Perry, in the last few days. Bea Maurer wants coaches for Eagle golf, starting next Tuesday, 4/30. Mary

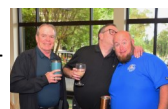
Lyn Kagan and Mike Barger rang the Bell. No speaker today but we were entertained learning many obscure facts about our
