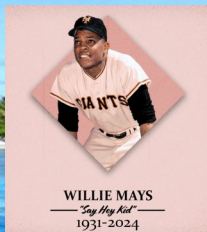

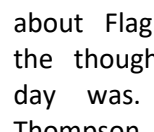


## SS Point West Voyage Log

about Flag Day for the thought of the day was. Sandy Thompson and Larry

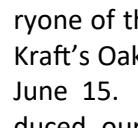


Challis presented a Paul Harris Fellowship to Coach Omar Marroquin

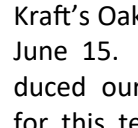


from Encina HS to honor the fantastic contributions he has made to our Partners in Leadership

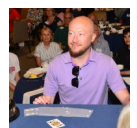


Cunha introduced our speaker, Robert Heidt, President of the Sacramento Metro Chamber of

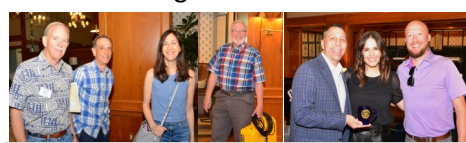
Commerce. Bob Tilly rang the bell. Don Levin, Tom Knox, and John Price gave Happy Bucks this meeting.
