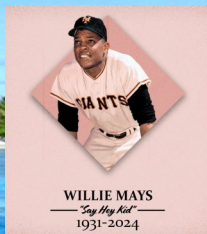

to celebrate the end of President Roger's term with a fantastic party. Roger was honored by Gary Pevey, Dominic Porrino, Lori Curry, Rich



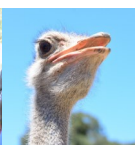
Price, Walter Helm, and Sandy Thompson. Paul Cunha had the last word. The food

ana Aguilar and Nancy Ly, recipients of Rotary Heilman Scholarships for there college expenses.

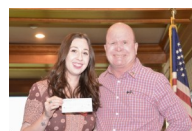


Jay Boatwright continues to plea for school supplies to

Happy Bucks were given by Mark Albrecht, Mike Barger,

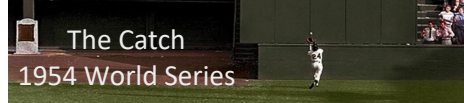
