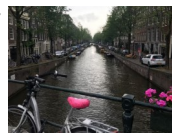
President Roger rings in the 9th meeting of the 39th term at DPCC. The pledge and our song, Margaritaville, are

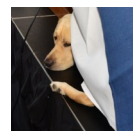

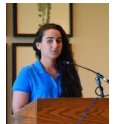
