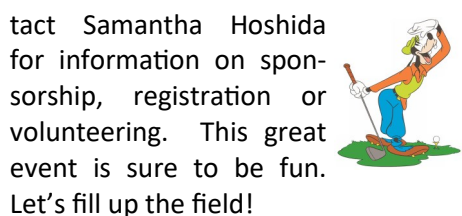
Point West Rotary Club Charity Golf Tournament
