### RI Foundation Month

RI is doing good in the world. That one idea, and an initial contribution of \$26.50, that has grown spent more than \$4 Billion on lifechanging. The various funds, Annual Fund. Endowment fund and Polio Plus combined have gown to \$1.5B with the plan to grow to \$2B by 2025. The Rotary Foundation is rated by Charity Navigator at 100/100 for the past several years. The Polio Plus campaign has helped reduce polio cases by 99% with only 2 countries left in the world with reported active native polio cases.
