The Point West Rotary Foundation was established in 1998 with the mission "to manage the funds entrusted to it in a lawful manner and to make available charitable funding in perpetuity for qualifies beneficiaries selected by the Point West Rotary Club". **Dan Hall**, Foundation President for 2021-22, presented the updated ideas and goals that the foundation has established for the next few years.

•There will be only one major fundraising event for PWR, the California Brewers Festival. We Plan to enhance the Brewfest to increase the generated revenue.

•The total fundraising goal will be \$250,000 annually with the fundraising year running March to March.
