## World Polio Day October 24

We are closing in on a polio free world. World **Polio Day** provides an opportunity to highlight global efforts toward a polio-free world and honor the tireless contributions of those on the frontlines in the fight to eradicate polio from every corner of the globe.

On August 25, 2020, the African Region was officially certified as wild poliovirus-free. With the African region's certification, five of the six WHO regions – representing over 90% of the world's population – are now free of the wild polioviruses. While we celebrate that achievement, the polio program remains focused on defeating polio in all its forms. Two countries remain with Wild type polio infections. We need to continue to be vigilant and keep up the fight to eradicate polio.

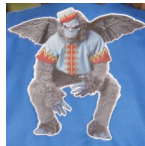
