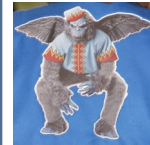
marketing, design, graphic production and printing, photography, and website design through a hand full of companies over the years. He brings those skills and enthusiasm to PWR.

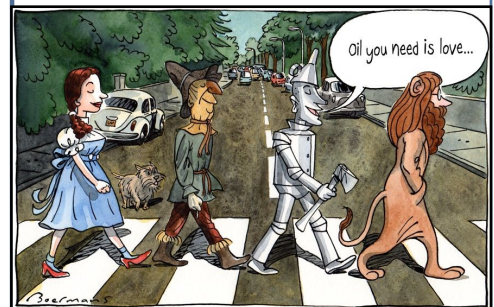
