## Holiday Meeting Giving Opportunity

Every year we come together for our last meeting of the year with our Holiday Extravaganza meeting. We celebrate the Holiday Season with song (the 12 Days of Christmas) and good cheer. We also take a moment to reflect on how fortunate we are to have family, friends, and our own financial security. It is a time to rejoice in what we have and to reflect on those who as less fortunate than us. Through the GRC our Club works hard to focus and direct the dollars that we have amassed in the Club Foundation toward causes that make a real difference in the lives of those very needy families in our community.

On December 17, at this final meeting of the year, we will be asking our members to donate to help us support those in need. You will have the opportunity to donate to the PWR Club Foundation in two ways. You can donate to the Club Foundation increasing the corpus now at \$1.6 million, or you can donate directly to the Grant Review Committee so that the Club Foundation funds can be used immediately for grants this term. The GRC started this year with a budget of \$83,100 and we are down to less than \$10,000 available to fund grants for the remainder of Mary Lyn's term. So far this term the GRC has awarded \$76,590 in grants funding local Title 1 schools, educational enrichment programs, food insecurity programs, foster child programs, refugee assimilation programs and other important programs for the needy. With a dwindling GRC budget it would be fantastic to receive additional funds from our generous PWR members' Christmas Meeting donations so that the GRC can continue to fund community grants through the end of Mary Lyn's term!
