

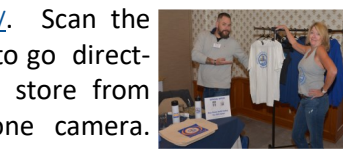

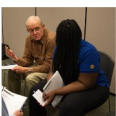


Partners in Leadership

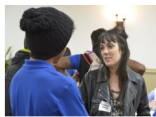
