Heilman Scholarship

The Heilman Scholarship provided by the Rotary Club of Point West - Sacramento (PWR) is a special scholarship in memory of Guy Heilman, who was a long time PWR member.

Guy was the Club meetings "leader of songs."

These scholarships are possible due to a generous donation from Mr. Heilman's family, donations from PWR members and Club fundraising.

Children and/or grandchildren of Rotary members are NOT eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Preparing Your Application

- Applicants must have a social security number or tax I.D. that you can provide if needed. You don't need this for the application, but may need to provide this information if you are declared a winner.
- You need to have a working email address that you can check on a regular basis.
- You need to have an email for your parent/guardian that is different from the email address that you list for yourself
- You should inform your parent/guardian that you are applying for this award. They will receive an email with instructions to endorse your application.
- You need to know the name, complete address, and telephone number of the school you wish to attend.
- You are required to submit a Letter of Recommendation from a school official who can
 endorse your application. This could be a teacher, counselor, prince or other school official who know your work and accomplishments. One or more optional Letter(s) of
 Recommendation can also be submitted by a coach or mentor from an out-of-school
 program you participate(d) in.
- Once submitted, your application CAN NOT be changed.
- Incomplete applications or applications that do not meet eligibility criteria will not be considered for this scholarship.

Scholarship Guidelines & Priorities

We are seeking graduating seniors with an interest in attending a trade/technical school or a 2-year or 4-year college. Those students interested in a trade area (i.e. automotive, construction, dental/medical, police/fire) are acceptable for this application.

A record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities is encouraged.

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan to further their education past high school. Scholarship funds will be paid in August for the first semester of the students first year directly to the college/school.

It will be the student's responsibility to submit to PWR an invoice for the scholarship payment. The invoice must contain the scholarship award amount as well as the student I.D. number and college/school information.

The application deadline is May 1st of each year. Late applications will NOT be accepted.
