

Joining the Rotary Club of Glenview Sunrise – Frequently Asked Questions

What is Rotary International? Rotary International is an international service organization of over 1.2 million members world- wide whose purpose is to bring together business and professional leaders in order to provide humanitarian services, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and to advance goodwill and peace around the world. The motto of Rotary International is "Service above Self".

What does the Rotary Club of Glenview Sunrise Do? The Club serves Glenview, the surrounding area, and the world through community, vocational, international, youth, and group programs. The club supports over a dozen local organizations through donations made possible through fund raising activities and the support of its members.

Why join? Through service to the community, members enjoy professional networking, experience personal growth & development, and make lasting friendships with professionals of diverse ethnic groups, political persuasions, languages, and religious beliefs.

What's the cost? Dues are \$168 per quarter. Bagels and coffee are available at the meetings for \$5. Reach out to a Club leader for the latest information.

What am I expected to donate? Subject to their personal giving budgets, members are encouraged to provide additional funds in support of Rotary's world-wide initiatives to promote human welfare. Rotary International recommends each member contribute \$100 or more to the Annual Fund, and the average contribution is more than \$200. Members also typically contribute \$35 to \$50 to PolioPlus and contribute a few dollars each week at meetings for activities.

How often do I need to attend? Members are encouraged to attend weekly, subject to individual personal and professional schedules.

How much time will it require? As much as you want to give! Members are encouraged to join one of the committees - Community Service, International Service, Vocational Service, Club Service, Membership/Public Relations, and the Hero Hustle. Remember the old adage: "The more you give, the more you get back"!

Where and when are the meetings? Meetings are typically held Thursday mornings at 7:00AM at the Glenview Community Ice Center, 1851 Landwehr, Glenview, 60026. Meetings are also transmitted via Zoom on-line.

Can I bring my kids? Absolutely! Just please make sure they are under your supervision.

How do I sign up? Sunrise is always looking for new members! After you attend 3 meetings as a guest of the Club, you are invited to fill out an application.
