3. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
4. Demonstrate a commitment to community service.
5. Accepted as a full-time student in any Idaho post-secondary education institution.
6. Attend the first semester of college following high school graduation.

#### **Instructions**

- Complete the Rotary Scholarship Application using your best penmanship. If you have a computer, you may answer each question on a separate sheet of paper and attach it to the Application provided. If using a computer, be sure to write your name on the Application and at the top of the second answer sheet and each additional sheet thereafter before printing and stapling to the Application.
- Include a copy of transcripts for grades 9 through 12 currently on file at your school.
- Sign the statement that you will comply with the terms of this award.
- Provide two letters of recommendation, one from a teacher or school advisor and one from the community (not related to you) who has known you for 2 years or more. The reference letters will discuss your potential for success at the college level, your character, achievements, and community service.
- Attach an essay of not more than 500 words sharing information about yourself, your academic interests, and your plans for the future.
