1. Be a resident of Idaho.
2. Have attended and completed 1 year of college (24 credit hours) **OR** be an adult at least 22 years of age or older attending college for the first year.
3. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher from your last educational institution or program.
4. Have demonstrated a commitment to community service.
6. Enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited post-secondary educational institution in **IDAHO**. This is a scholarship to attend an **IDAHO** college or university.

### **Instructions:**

- Complete the Rotary Scholarship Application using your best penmanship. If you have a computer, you may answer each question on a separate sheet of paper and attach it to the application provided. If using a computer, be sure to write your name on the Application and at the top of the second answer sheet and each additional sheet thereafter before printing and stapling to the application.
- Provide a copy of your transcripts from your last attended institution.
- Include a copy of your Idaho driver's license or Idaho Identification card. (photo id)
- Include a personal resume.
- Provide two letters of recommendation, one from a teacher/professor, school advisor or an employer and one from the community (not related to you) who has known you for 2 years or more. The reference letters will discuss your potential for success at the college level, your character, achievements, and community service.
- Attach an essay of not more than 500 words sharing information about yourself, your academic interests, and your plans for the future.
