Areas of Focus: Promoting Peace

For the next few weeks, Rotaview is exploring Rotary's six Areas of Focus to enhance our local and global impact. Today's focus: Promoting Peace.

Sixty-five million people are displaced by armed conflict or persecution and 90 percent of armed-conflict casualties are civilians; half of them are children. Through service projects, fellowships, and other Rotary-sponsored campaigns, members train adults and young leaders to prevent and mediate conflict and to aid refugees who have fled dangerous areas. Members also pursue projects to address the underlying structural causes of conflict, including poverty, inequality, ethnic tension, lack of access to education, and unequal distribution of resources.
