### Altus Koegelenberg, Jon Kral

Enoch's Stomp Vineyard & Winery

When Altus Koegelenberg and Jon Kral founded Enoch's Stomp in 2004, they had little idea what it would become.

A dozen years later, it continues to grow and expand both its selection of wines and activities available at the winery in Harleton.

It all happened almost by accident, the co-owners told Rotarians and guests last week. In 2003, Koegelenberg, a fifth generation grape grower from South Africa, moved his family to America in search of a more secure life. A fateful encounter with Kral, a chemist with a love of nature, led to the vineyard and winery known as Enoch's Stomp.

The property today features 12 acres of grape vines including the varieties Black Spanish (a.k.a. Lenoir), Blanc DuBois, Norton (a.k.a. Cynthiana), Villard Blanc, Champanel, and Chambourcin, Koegelenberg said. These varieties, as opposed to the more common vinifera grapes (i.e. Merlot, Chardonnay), are well suited for the East Texas terroir, where variable weather patterns, heat, humidity and disease create unique challenges.

Since its inception, Enoch's Stomp has accumulated more than 110 medals, the majority belonging to its signature white wine, Blanc DuBois. In addition to wines, Enoch's provides fine dining Friday and Saturday evenings, seasonal events and facilities rentals. For more information, visit [enochsstomp.com](http://enochsstomp.com).

### Rotarians at work for Guatemala

Last week's load out of equipment bound for the Hospital Nacional de San Benito in the Peten area of Guatemala was a success, thanks to the Rotarians and others who turned out to do the heavy lifting.

"We had great help loading very heavy hospital beds and other medical equipment," said Past District Governor Carroll Greenwaldt. "We estimate the 25 hospital beds weighed almost 400 pounds each and they had to be lifted shoulder high to get them into the back doors of the Dole semi-truck containers."

There also were other items to be loaded: About 30 lighter, metal frame beds; a crash cart; patient lifting device; and loads of miscellaneous equipment that will help in this desperately needy area.

"We filled two semi-truck sized shipping containers," Greenwaldt said. "Thanks to all!"
