### Steve Russell Empowering Texas Youth

Steve Russell is on a mission to spread awareness of Search Institute Inc.'s "Forty Developmental Assets" and the influence they have to promote positive attitudes and behaviors for children and youth and to protect them from many problem behaviors.

None of the 40 assets, or building blocks, of healthy development is revolutionary, he told members and guests last week. But taken together, they can provide the framework of internal and external forces a child needs to be successful.

And, he said, the need for such a framework extends to all children. "You tend to think that children with problems come from lower cultural or socioeconomic groups," he said. "That is absolutely not true."

The assets, which were arrived at through polling and research of successful children and young adults, are divided into two groups of 20 internal and 20 external assets. As an example, Russell mentioned one external asset: Parent involvement in schooling. Of course it's a no-brainer that a successful child will have a parent actively involved in education, he said, but all the assets are common sense ideas. "That's a checkbox. It's one of the 40 that, together, will have an impact."

Ensuring another checkbox is marked – young person serves in the community an hour or more per week – is a different sort of investment in a child, Russell said, but just as important. "When you ask a young person to do something, you invest faith and confidence in that child."

### Polio eradication update

Last week was the third straight week with no new polio cases reported anywhere around the globe. It's further proof that, thanks to your continuing generous support, Rotary is truly are "this close" to eradicating polio.

Here's a look at the situation at the end of last week in the last two endemic countries:

**Pakistan:** No new polio cases reported last week. So far this year 13 cases have been reported, compared with 54 cases recorded in 2015. National Immunization Days are planned Aug. 18-19 and committed health care workers are going to great lengths to build trust and ensure every child is vaccinated.

**Afghanistan:** No new polio cases reported last week. So far this year six cases have been reported, compared with 20 cases recorded in 2015. National Immunization Days are planned Aug. 22-25.

**Elsewhere:** In post-endemic Nigeria, no cases have been reported this year and none were reported last year. The most recent case was reported July 24, 2014.

Here's the situation in importation countries: Ethiopia (0-2015, 1-2014), Cameroon (0-2015, 5-2014), Somalia (0-2015, 5-2014), Iraq (0-2015, 2- 2014), Syria (0-2015,1-2014), and Equatorial Guinea (0-2015, 5-2014).
