2016-2017 Rotary Year

“Welcome to a new Rotary year,” Gordon Northcutt told Rotarians and guests after being inducted at our last meeting. “As your incoming president, it is my task to define a few goals for our club for the coming year.”

With that, President Gordon began laying out three main goals for us to achieve this year, goals he said were realistic and put the focus on moving our club forward.

“Our first goal,” he said, “pertains to membership. Growing our club will be of the utmost importance.” The numeric goal he set is a net gain of 12 new members on the roster by June 30, 2017. It will be reached by having an active membership committee but also by each of us working to actively recruit members. Gordon challenged each Rotarian to think of two or three people to invite to a Rotary meeting. “Why not?” he asked. “Why not tell our friends about the work of Rotary and invite them?” Other efforts will include quarterly socials, increased emphasis on outreach through social media and our club website, and new recruiting and informational materials.

“Our second goal is to get every Rotarian involved with the club in some way not related to flags,” President Gordon said. To that end, he is planning a committee job fair as part of our July 26 meeting. At that event, every member will be given an opportunity to learn more about the committees and to sign up to help. Educating all members about the work of club committees and Rotary will be a part of this goal, he said, as will an interest survey being prepared for the fall.

“Our third goal is for us to talk more about Rotary,” he said. “It’s time for us to toot our own horn.” Beyond continuing to focus on our fundraising success, that means focusing more on the work of Rotary and its activities both in our community and the world. Then each of us can share that information with others.

“I hope these three goals are simple, achievable and straightforward,” President Gordon said. I’m excited to be your president, I’m proud to be president of the Rotary Club of Longview, and I want to thank all of you for your support and all the feedback you can give me during the year.”
