Texas Shakespeare Festival

After 30 seasons, and halfway through its 31st, the Texas Shakespeare Festival continues to grow because of the support provided by East Texas, the company's artistic associates told Rotarians and guests last week.

In the midst of a season in which the festival is offering six plays, Meaghan Simpson and Matthew Simpson talked about the community that became their home and that supports the festival financially, by attending performances, providing meals, housing cast and crew members and in many other ways. It's a supportive atmosphere, they said, that attracted them to relocate to East Texas to give their full-time attention to the festival. They also provided a look at this year's shows, most of which are sold out.

Performances are scheduled through Sunday in the Van Cliburn Auditorium at Kilgore College's Anne Dean Turk Fine Arts Center, 1200 S. U.S.259.

The season features the plays "The Merchant of Venice," "Blithe Spirit," "Henry V," "Carousel," "The Belle of Amherst" and "Spirit of the Sea."

Tickets cost from \$20 to \$30, and tickets for the children's show, "Spirit of the Sea," cost \$7.

Board approves 2016-2017 meetings calendar

Your board last week unanimously approved a resolution setting dates on which we will not meet in the 2016-2017 Rotary year. These are dates that fall immediately before or after holidays, when members either will be tending to family commitments or Rotary flag duties, as we did July 5.

The canceled meeting dates are:

- Sept. 6 (Tuesday after Labor Day; flag duty)
- Dec. 27 (Tuesday after Christmas)
- Jan. 3 (Tuesday after New Year's Day)
- Feb. 21 (Tuesday after President's Day; flag duty)
- May 30 (Tuesday after Memorial Day; flag duty)

The board also resolved to continue conducting its meetings from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the third Wednesday of each month at Gerald's, 106 E. Tyler Ave.

Early outs creating issues for flag committee

Flag teams routinely servicing their routes early are causing additional work for the flag committee and other members, the board was told last week.

When customers begin seeing flags put out a day or two early on other routes, some are concerned they have been missed or missed a payment and contact committee members for explanation. Early outs also have created some problems and additional work at the flag barn.

We fully understand there are occasionally business or personal demands that require teams to put out flags at times other than those scheduled and such deviations are acceptable. But the committee and board are asking teams to make every effort to follow scheduled times and dates so all flags go out at the same time citywide.
