Last week's meeting

Roy Miller East Texas Regional Airport

Gregg County aviation has seen a lot of changes

in the years since the terminal at East Texas Regional Airport opened in 1947, Airport Director Roy Miller told members and guests last week. Not least among those changes have been changes to the terminal itself.

"It was renovated in 1987 and then we renovated it again the last two years," said Miller, who took over the airport in late 2012. "It's named after Henry Atkinson, and we rededicated it this past year. Judge Atkinson put a lot of support in the airport out there, spent a lot of money, and it's really something Gregg County can be proud of."

The most recent renovation, a \$4.6 million job

that was dedicated this past fall, brought an expanded passenger check-in area, a 650-square foot jet bridge to protect passengers from the elements while boarding and leaving American Eagle flights, an expanded baggage carousel and expanded waiting and reception areas with new restrooms. From outside, according to before and after pictures Miller showed, the terminal looks completely different than it did before.

Inside, an old feature of the airport was uncovered and has been turned into a jewel of the renovation. As demolition was underway at the beginning of the project, an original terra cotta floor engrained with a map of Gregg County and surrounding cities was discovered and has become a centerpiece of the terminal.

Miller made clear that commercial aviation is only one part of a multifaceted operation at the airport, however. He referred to LeTourneau University's aviation program there as "one of the best professional aviation schools in the country." There are two fixed base operators on the airport, he said, referring to Stebbins Aviation and KRS, which both offer services to general aviation. Aerosmith Aviation Inc. is a company that paints and refurbishes aircraft from the smallest Cessna to a 737, Miller said, and Gregg Aircraft Services repairs airplanes of all types. In addition to all that, the Texas Department of Public Safety maintains an aviation unit at the airport.

"We also have a great community of general aviation," Miller said, referring to the non-commercial activity at the airport. It includes a fleet of about 20 privately operated jets and about as many turboprops. "So there's a lot of activity here."
