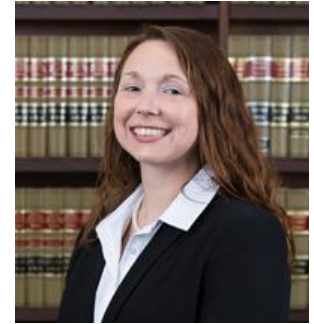
Welcome our newest member
