Rotary Citizen of the Year

Anne Hugman

Anyone who's driven past the renovated Longview Community Center or been in a Gregg County courtroom lately has seen the professional impact Anne Hugman has had on her adopted city.

Less visible are the architect's volunteer impacts, such as steering a professional women's organization in a local war on human trafficking and helping design a comprehensive city plan shaping Longview into future decades. Then there are the children she helped educate during two terms as a Longview ISD trustee.

That comprehensive imprint on the city she joined in 1987 was cited last week as Hugman, co-owner of Hugman Architecture & Construction, was named the Rotary Club of Longview's 2016 Citizen of the Year.

"Anne believes in Longview," said real estate broker Suzanne Cook. She described her friend of 25 years as one who would be picked first on a middle school softball field.

"Because she's a team player," Cook said, before describing Hugman's insistence the comprehensive plan for Longview reflect residents' stated preference for more parks and nature trails.

Glenn McCutchen, former member of the Rotary Club of Longview and retired publisher of the Longview News-Journal, recalled expansion and renovations the Hugman firm undertook for the newspaper. McCutchen said he and Hugman had tussled a bit over the wallpaper in his office.

"She said, 'We'll use your choice, but when we get through you'll wish we'd used mine.' And you know? She was right," McCutchen said.

Retired Longview educator Janis Canion highlighted the Zonta Club of Longview's focus on raising awareness of and combating human sex trafficking in the city. Hugman led that charge as Zonta's president for 2014-15.

"She changed Zonta Club, so that at this time the largest Zonta Club in the world has brought to this city an initiative that addressed the issue of sex trafficking," Canion said. "And I am very proud of Anne. Thank you for leading us in that role."

Hugman included the Zonta trafficking effort in brief remarks accepting the honor. "It's working," she said. "We've raised a lot of money. The initiative is going to work."

The honoree hugged her husband and business partner, Rotarian Jim Hugman, before being presented with a Paul Harris Fellow, her second.
