

# 2016 Citizen of the Year



## P. Anne Hugman

**D**epending on your perspective, you may know P.

Anne Hugman as the architect whose business has put its imprint on public and private spaces across our area. Maybe you remember her for the years she spent as a trustee on the Longview ISD school board. Or you may know her as the woman who, as president of the Zonta Club of Longview, made you aware of the scourge of human trafficking.

Over the years, her name also has risen to public attention for her work leading the Longview Chamber of Commerce, as a member of the Longview 2020 group and for her work with the Longview Museum of Fine Arts, Junior League of Longview and many other groups and efforts across the city.

It is the totality of her contributions, made both as a volunteer and through her family business, for which the Rotary Club of Longview today honors Anne with its Citizen of the Year Award.

Anne graduated from the University of Arizona in 1982 with a bachelor of architecture, then served apprenticeships with architectural firms in the Dallas area. In 1986, she married Jim Hugman and by 1987 was working in Longview. She worked with a couple of local architectural firms before becoming a partner in Hugman Architecture & Construction Inc. with husband Jim.

Their first child, Elissa, was born in 1989. Their second, Robert, arrived in 1991. For the next few years, Anne and Jim were busy building their business and raising their family. But Anne's name was often in the news from 2002 to 2008, the years she served Longview ISD District 2 as a trustee on the school board.

From 2008 to 2013, Anne was a board member of the Longview Museum of Fine Arts, a period that saw the museum celebrate its 50<sup>th</sup> year, its façade renovated and the opening of the ArtWorks Creative Learning Center.

During those same years, Anne was involved in successful campaigns of the Greater Longview United Way, serving in 2012-13 as campaign co-chair with Jim. The record-breaking campaign they led helped fund programs across the city at increased levels.

She also served in 2011 as chairman of the board of the Longview Chamber of Commerce, and was 2014-15 president of the Zonta Club of Longview.

Under Anne's leader-

ship, Zonta launched a campaign to educate our community about the ugly reality of sex trafficking. The program she began has led to grants for police training and equipment, as well as educational efforts across the region. Zonta's work mentoring young women and providing scholarships continues to have a positive impact.

Anne also served as a member of the city of Longview Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee & Development Task Force, and is a current member of the city's Construction Advisory and Appeals Board. A recent effort is as a member of the board raising funds for the Longview Arboretum and Nature Center just beginning construction.

The Rotary Club of Longview is not the first organization to give Anne special recognition for her work. In 2007, she was named one of Longview Regional Medical Center's Stars Over Longview. In 2014, the Longview Chamber of Commerce honored her with its Chairman's Award for Community Contributions. And in 2012, she was named a Woman of Achievement by the Zonta Club of Longview.

As she was honored by Zonta, Gregg County Judge Bill Stoudt remarked what a difference Anne has made in Longview. "She has helped make Longview more attractive, and she's an outstanding example of using the path of volunteerism to advance opportunities for women," he said.

Longview Chamber of Commerce President Kelly Hall said Anne's volunteer efforts always reflected a clear and compelling vision for the community.

"She's never sitting still," Hall said. "She jumped into our community with both feet and has done a lot to make it better for all of us."
