In Memoriam

Gordon Hargett

Marine, Rotarian

Gordon Hargett was an 18-year-old student when Japan bombed Pearl Harbor on Dec. 7, 1941. After the attack, he asked his mother for permission to join the U.S. Marine Corps and go fight. After he got it, he rode his bicycle 33 miles from Fort Worth to the Dallas recruiting office and enlisted.

That sort of dedication stuck with Mr. Hargett as a Rotarian, as he doggedly made his way to weekly meetings and occasional social gatherings – in later years on a walker – and accumulated 51 years of perfect attendance.

Mr. Hargett, who served two tours in the Pacific Theater during World War II, died Friday. He was 92.

The accomplishment of his 50th year of perfect Rotary attendance was honored in 2012 with a cake, special badge and a slideshow of the big news of 1962. Wearing his new 50-year badge, Mr. Hargett reminisced about the day he got his first Rotary badge, at a meeting in 1962 in the old Longview Hotel, and about what it meant for him to be a Rotarian.

"I appreciate all of this hullabaloo that you did for me," he said of being honored. "But it's really easy if you just make up your mind."

He was discharged from the Marines in 1946 but remained an active member of the Marine Corps League in Longview and was instrumental in the group's annual Toys for

Tots drive (photo above, from 2002). His love for the Marines was even reflected in his e-mail address: bigdaddyUSMC@sbcglobal.net.

His active duty included being part of the force that invaded Okinawa. The invasion was the largest amphibious assault in the Pacific War. Mr. Hargett, by then a corporal, served on an artillery crew supporting Marines in the frontline battles.

After the war, Mr. Hargett worked for Convair (now General Dynamics), LTV (Ling-Temco-Vought) Aircraft and Panther Chemicals. In 1970 he started Mingo Sales, a chemical sales firm he continued to operate.

Funeral services are set for 2 p.m. Friday at Rader Funeral Home in Longview. Visitation will be from 5 to 7 p.m. Thursday at the funeral home.
