House of Disciples is on a drive to more than double the capacity of its ministry to men who are struggling with life-control problems.

"The key to a person's recovery is that they find a relationship with God," said Tim Wiseman, executive director. Their best chance to do that is if they stay in his program to completion. While 86 percent of those who enter the ministry's existing downtown facilities leave within a month, he said, if they stay 120 days or beyond they'll likely complete the program.

A new facility Wiseman is planning near Carthage aims to help make that happen more often.

House of Disciples is working to establish its fifth location, which will be on a working blackberry farm. Wiseman is in the process of raising \$1.5 million to purchase and do minor renovations to make the farm a part of the ministry.

"With your help even more lives will be changed and more families restored," he said. "I'm telling you this not to come begging for money, but to show you that we have a future, and we do have a vision. The Bible says that people without a vision perish. We have a vision."
