Longview Lobos Athletic Director, Head Football Coach

As the Lobos faced an open week after falling to Louisiana power Shreveport Byrd to fall to 2-1 on the young season, Longview ISD athletic director and head coach John King joined us to discuss progress of all the district's athletic programs.

Despite the non-district loss, King said the Lobos were looking forward to getting into their district schedule and heading to playoffs.

"No more breaks from here on out," he said. "It was a good break, a needed one, but it's good to have a game coming up. It'll be a seven-week district race ahead of us."

The Lobos joined Pine Tree, Hallsville, Greenville, Mount Pleasant and Sulphur Springs with a night off this past Friday.

"You could tell early on that our district was going to be improved and I think that it has," he said. "I think through our non-district schedules, we've lived up to that billing."



Board approves service grants

A conference to shed light on the issue of poverty, an organization building a Longview center that aims to help mothers and their children, financial support for patients at an equine therapy center and a park that honors Americans who have died in service to their country will receive financial support from our club this year.

Your board last week approved \$15,000 in grants to the Junior League of Longview, Buckner Children and Family Services, Windridge Therapeutic Equestrian Center and Veterans Recognition Foundation for a variety of projects across Longview.

Here's a closer look:

The Junior League of Longview will receive \$5,000 to bring Geoffrey Canada to discuss "The Crisis Facing Youth: What We Can Do to Save Our Children and Revitalize Our Community." Canada is keynote speaker at the Poverty Conference set for Oct. 15 at the Belcher Center at LeTourneau University.

Buckner Children and Family Services also will receive \$5,000 to assist with transitional services in Longview after the organization completes its new facility in South Longview.

Windridge Therapeutic and Equestrian Center will receive \$3,000 to provide scholarship assistance to patients who need financial support to receive services.

The Veterans Recognition Foundation will receive \$2,000 for construction of a memorial wall at the Veterans Plaza that's being developed at Teague Park to honor all Americans who have served in uniform since 1770.
