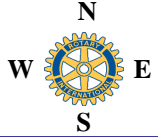

ROTARY PEACE FELLOWSHIPS

District 5790 has an eleven year history of success in winning Rotary Peace Fellowships. This Rotary program provides peace fellowships to highly qualified students and professionals pursuing either a master's degree in such fields as international development, peace studies, and conflict resolution, or a professional development certificate in peace and conflict studies.

Districts are encouraged to nominate qualified candidates for the worldwide competitive selection of up to 100 peace fellows each year. Candidates have until 31 May to submit applications to their district.

Districts submit endorsed applications to the Foundation by 1 July. Rotary Clubs should start recruiting and interviewing eligible candidates as early as January. Clubs nominate candidates to the District 5790 peace fellowship subcommittee chair and the district Rotary Foundation chair. The District 5790 peace fellow nominees are interviewed by: the DG, IPDG, RFDC, district peace fellowship chair, district scholarship chair, and one or two former Rotary World Peace Fellows within the district.

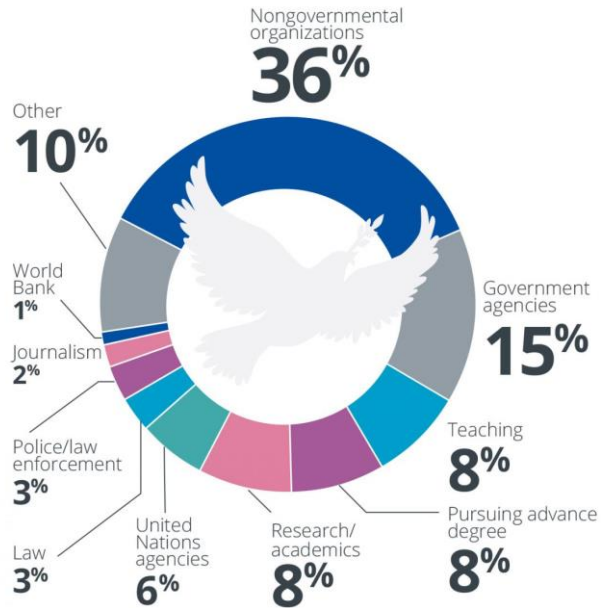
