

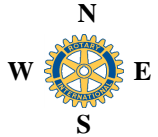

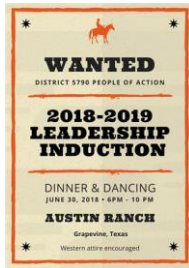
Celebrate Rotary Western Style!
